Cherokee Regional Trail - Ohio to Smith Avenue	City of St. Paul	\$136,375	City of St. Paul	This project is to construct a 1.3 mile regional trail within Cherokee Regional Park.
Asphalt Restoration	Goodhue County	\$31,500	Goodhue County	This project is to restore the asphalt trail surface on the Cannon Valley Trail.
Mile 16 Trail Relocation Project	Goodhue County	\$18,750	Goodhue County	This project is to restore the trail shoulder at mile 16 on the Cannon Valley Trail.
North Country Trail Construction in Becker County	Goodhue County	\$100,000	Goodhue County	This project is to develop 40 miles of the North Country Trail in Becker County between Elbow Lake Road and the City of Frazee.
North-Woods Regional ATV Trail	Aitkin County	\$155,000	Aitkin County	This project is to develop a 70 mile ATV/OHV trail in Aitkin and Itasca Counties.
Shingobee Connection Trail Phase 2 and 3	Shingobee Township	\$175,000	Shingobee Township	This project is to develop phase 2 and 3 of a paved multi-use trail connecting the City of Walker and the Paul Bunyan State Trail.
Superior Hiking Trail Construction Alden Township	Alden Township	\$20,000	Alden Township	This project is to construct 5.1 miles of the Superior Hiking Trail from Fox Farm Road West Trail head to the East Trail head in Alden Township.
TH 169 Multi-Use Trail-Phase 2	City of Grand Rapids	\$140,000	City of Grand Rapids	This project is to construct 2.4 miles of bituminous/concrete trail that will connect the cities of Grand Rapids, Cohasset and LaPrairie to the Mesabi Trail.
Cross City Trail (aka Munger Trail Extention)	City of Duluth	\$175,000	City of Duluth	This project is to construct 7.3 miles of the Cross City Trail to connect the Munger Trail in West Duluth to the Lakewalk Trail in Downtown Duluth.
Rush Creek Trail	City of Rushford	\$175,000	City of Rushford	This project is to construct 1 mile of new trail connecting the 42 mile Root River State Trail to the Rushford Area.
Greenway Corridor East Cannon River Trail	City of Northfield	\$150,000	City of Northfield	This project is to develop a 3 mile multi-use trail along the east side of the Cannon River in the City of Northfield.
Elm Creek Recreational Trail (Phase I and II)	Three Rivers Park District	\$90,000	Three Rivers Park District	This project is to construct a new sustainable single track trail in the Elm Creek Park Reserve for mountain bikers, hikers, trail runners and snowshoers that has two difficulty levels.

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Minnesota River Valley Trail Segment	City of New Ulm	\$100,000	City of New Ulm	This project is to construct 2,600 feet of new bituminous trail that will connect Riverside Park to Minnecon Park along the Minnesota River.
Rehabilitate the Soo Line Trail Trestles - Moose Lake	Carlton County	\$50,000	Carlton County	This project is to rehabilitate the trestles on the Soo Line Trail in Moose Lake by replacing the decking and installing new steel post guard rails and chain link fencing.
Bertram Chain of Lakes	Wright County	\$400,000	Wright County	Phase two acquisition of a portion of the remaining 881 acres of Bertram Chain of Lakes Park. When completed the total project will encompass 1,200 acres of land and water, including four undeveloped lakes, 5.85 miles of lake shore and 1.5 miles of streams.
Quarry Park & Nature Preserve	Stearns County	\$400,000	Stearns County	Acquire 39.5 acres adjacent to the existing 643-acre Quarry Park and Nature Preserve and the DNR's 300-acre Quarry Park SNA. This key acquisition will open up a southern entrance serving the rapidly expanding St. Cloud metro area.
Lake Washington Park	Le Sueur County	\$400,000	Le Sueur County	Phase 1 master plan development, campground, comfort station, picnic shelters, park roads, trails, playground and parking,
Lake Koronis Regional Park	Meeker County	\$150,000	Meeker County	Renovate campground including three camper cabins, park office and accessible storm shelter building, early warning system (safety) and a playground.
Quarry Hill Nature Center	City of Rochester	\$200,000	City of Rochester	Pond enhancement project to repair and expand an existing man made pond to improve outdoor recreational opportunities for park visitors that use the pond for fishing, boating and wildlife viewing. The pond is used by over 20,000 school students each year for aquatic studies and recreation.
Alexander Ramsey Park	City of Redwood Falls	\$141,625	City of Redwood Falls	Renovate the Ramsey Falls pedestrian overlook according to developed architectural plans, provide erosion control and enhance public safety while viewing.
